COLLEGE IS AFFORDABLE

You can go to college even if no one in your family has gone before. You do not have to be wealthy to afford college; you can apply for Financial Aid and implement a savings plan that works for your family

Keep these Key Points in mind as you plan for your future



You may be eligible for Financial Aid

Most Financial Aid is based upon a simple equation (Cost of Education -Estimated Family Contribution = Estimated Financial Assistance)



Always Apply! Even if you think you do not qualify, *APPLY ANYWAY.* You have nothing to lose by applying and everything to gain

Research Scholarship opportunities early and often, and apply for as many as possible



While you're in middle school, you don't have to spend a lot of time on details about financial aid yet

For now, remember that *you can go to college*, there are ways to make college affordable, and become as involved as you can with clubs and activities that will help you apply for college
