## Who is NextGen for?

- Ages 16 -24
- In or out of school
- Have a documented barrier\*
- Need additional assistance to enter or complete an education program or to secure or hold employment



### Piedmont Triad Regional NextGen Youth Program

The Piedmont Triad Regional NextGen Youth Program serves youth ages 16-24 in Caswell, Davie, Forsyth, Rockingham, Stokes, Surry and Yadkin Counties in Piedmont Triad North Carolina. The focus of the Youth Program is helping youth overcome barriers that limit their ability to become productive members of society and in the workforce.

Youth who may be eligible to receive services must meet program eligibility requirements. Some factors that may be considered are low income, a documented disability, deficient in basic literacy skills, school dropout, homeless, runaway, foster child, pregnant or parenting youth, and youth with a criminal background.

The primary goal of the Youth Program is to provide a structure and sense of accomplishment in the lives of youth served by the program.

\*Federally defined barriers include: deficient in basic literacy skills, school dropout, homeless, runaway, foster children, pregnant or parenting youth, youth with criminal background, individual with a disability, English language learner

### Youth Staff

Our staff will work with youth in these key areas:

- Comprehensive guidance and counseling services supporting secondary education, post secondary education and career goals
- Program support leading to the completion of secondary school
- Dropout prevention strategies
- Tutoring & study skills training
- Leadership development
- Supportive services
- Alternative secondary school services
- Paid and unpaid work experiences
- Occupational skills training
- Adult mentoring
- Financial literacy
- Entrepreneurial skills training
- Labor market, in-demand occupational & career pathways
- Follow-up services for at least 12 months

### NextGen Youth Services

NextGen Youth Services are comprised of two main components: education and employment. Completion of a secondary educational program is the first and foremost goal. Youth Staff members also provide post secondary education counseling and career preparation guidance.

- Education planning assistance
- Career Pathway Assessments to help pursue careers
- Leadership skills development
- Job readiness training
- Work experience opportunities
- Employment placement services
