- o Submit a Last Dollar Grant Application or at least 1 Scholarship Application

^ College Fair/College Visit may be completed in Sophomore or Junior years. Community Service may be completed in Junior year.

And continue to:

- o Agree to random drug-screening
- Fulfill terms of Partnership Agreement
- o Maintain enrollment in and graduate from a Forsyth County public school
- o Complete the Program with a cumulative weighted GPA of 2.0 or higher to be eligible to apply for Last Dollar Grant funding.


