Our vision is to ensure that every public school student in Forsyth County has the opportunity to attend college.

OBJECTIVES OF THE EXCELENCIA PROGRAM

- Educate Hispanic parents about educational requirements and opportunities for their middle and high school girls.
- Educate families about academic excellence, scholarships, high school graduation requirements and college enrollment criteria for colleges and universities.
- Help Hispanic middle and high school girls understand the benefits of a higher education.
- Facilitate *Exitotal* workshops to help guide parents on how to work as a team with their child and the school system
- Work with the program *¡Soy Unica! ¡Soy Latina!* to help girls understand who they are and enhance their self-esteem.
- Reduce or eliminate the school dropout rate among Hispanic girls.
