Quick Facts: Crosby Scholars Community Partnership

The Crosby Scholars Community Partnership is a college access program for 6th-12th grade students in Forsyth County public schools. Since 1992, the Program has prepared students academically, financially and personally for successful college enrollment, free of charge. Through an affiliation with Goodwill of Northwest North Carolina, a second Crosby Scholars Program was established in Rowan County in 2013 and a third in Iredell County in 2015.

Our vision is to ensure that every public school student in Forsyth County has the opportunity to attend college.

The Crosby Scholars Program

- 14,264 Crosby Scholars graduates since 1993
- 100% high school graduation rate
- Enrolls 98% of high school seniors in a two- or four-year college or university immediately after graduation
- Awarded more than \$11 million and leveraged more than \$111.6 million in financial support since 1993
- Requires students to attend academies on goal setting, stress management, academic skills, leadership development, college admissions, SAT/ACT preparation and financial aid planning.
- Crosby Scholars take the It's My Call pledge to remain drug and alcohol-free.
- Encourages students to be involved in their community through a community service requirement.

Class of 2023 Snapshot

- Graduated 925 senior Crosby Scholars
- Awarded \$933,620 in Last Dollar Grants and Scholarship for the 2022-23 academic year
- Graduates enrolled in 141 colleges and universities throughout North Carolina and across the world
- 37% of seniors were active participants in Crosby Scholars since joining the program in 6th grade
- 36% of Crosby Scholar seniors were first-generation college-going students
- The Class of 2023 reported 9,925 hours of community service

How Many Students Are We Reaching?

- Currently serving 10,000 middle and high school students in Forsyth County
- Crosby Scholars has assisted over 36,450 students, including 37% of all public school students in WS/FC Schools over the last 30 years
- Program enrollment has grown 30% since 2015
- Available in 24 middle schools and 20 high schools
